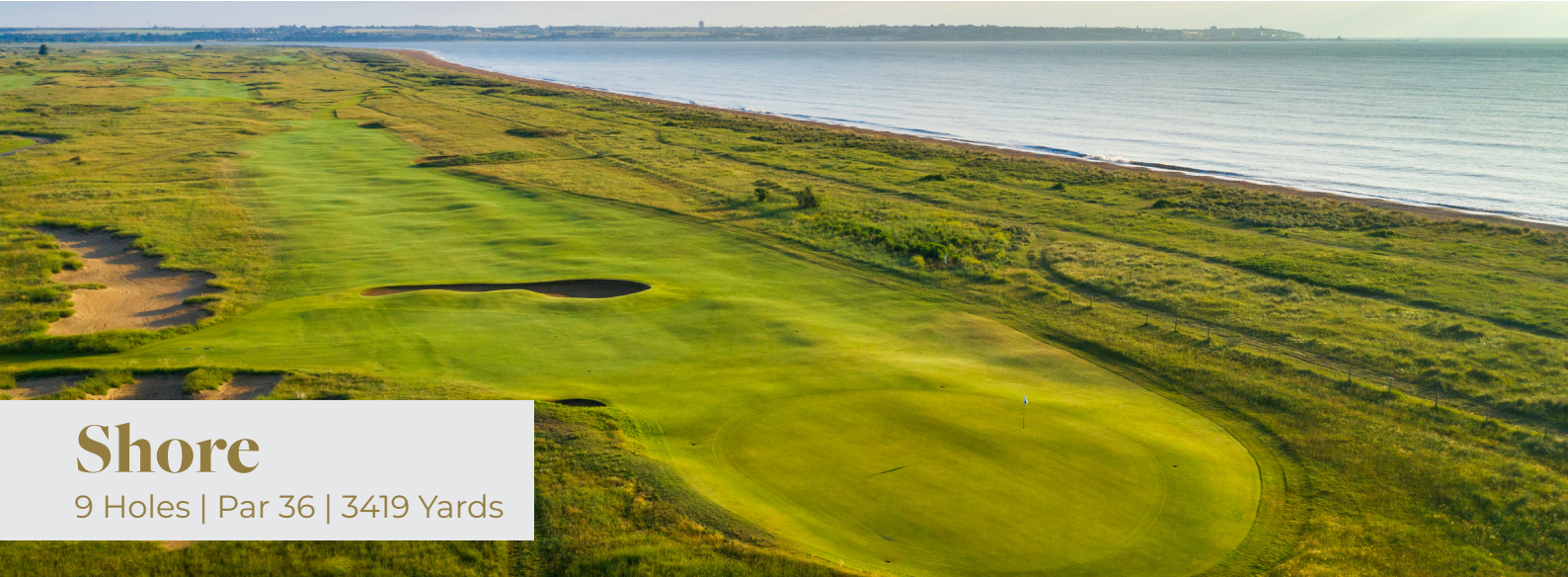
Apartments

Prince's Golf Club, located near the quaint town of Sandwich, Kent, offers 27 holes of Championship links golf in an idyllic coastal setting.



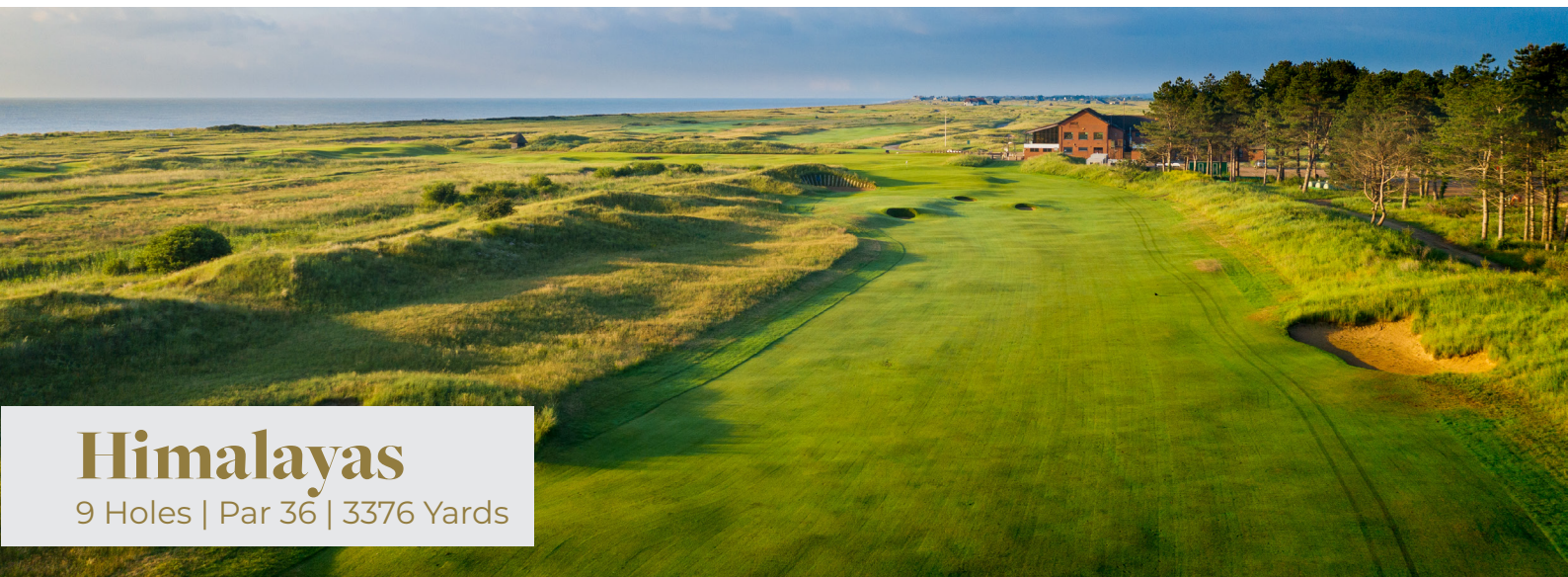

Prince's

Established in 1906, the original course at Prince's was highly thought of within the golfing fraternity. So much so, that in 1932 Prince's hosted The Open Championship, which was memorably won by legendary golfer, Gene Sarazen.



Having undergone extensive damage during World War II, the course and landscaped changed dramatically. In recent years however, the courses have been extensively yet respectfully redeveloped, under the dutiful eye of renowned architects Mackenzie & Ebert. This period, which began in 2017 has seen a transformative change across the 27 Championship holes at Prince's. With a return of some pre-war aesthetics, including vast open sand scrapes and dramatic green complexes with blended run off areas, the club has found a balance between modern ambience and historic charm.



Recently, Prince's has re-established its championship pedigree hosting Final Qualifying for The Open from 2019-2022 and recently being announced as hosts of the 120th Women's Amateur Championship in 2023.

The extensive works, renewed emphasis on year-round conditioning, and strive for continuous improvement has led to Prince's re-establishing itself firmly within the top 100 golf course in Great Britain and Ireland with all reputable raters.
